The time has once again arrived to share with all of you what I have found and some of what you already know. The major part of my research hours are spent trying to track down more information about Gottlieb Marti. (See update in this issue.) I also research other members of our ancestors along with trying to update current data about all our descendants. I also keep records on all four families of my ancestors. This proves to be a sizable undertaking.

My mothers families have been well researched by others and I only have to update new arrivals and add information about those that I am able to find. I am at present doing no ancestral research on my mothers side of the family.

As many of you know the VonFange side of my father's family is being actively worked on by the VonFange's. Consequently I am not doing any intentional research on the VonFanges. However if I find the name in my readings I record it and attempt to connect my information to the correct individual or family. This policy is also true for my mothers family.

I got started researching the MARTY'S because I did not know of anyone who had dug deeply into the family history.

HERMAN HENRY MARTY
(1883-1961)

Herman Henry Marty was born Friday, 14 September 1883 at Beardstown, Cass County, Illinois, to George Carl Marty and Maggie (Hobrock) Marty. He died Monday, 9 October 1961 at Salina, Saline, Kansas, at the age of 78 years 25 days. Herman is buried at Gypsum Hill Cemetery, Salina, Kansas. He was the first of three children and moved with his parents to Elkhorn Township, Lincoln County, Kansas around 1887. Herman had one brother John Amil Marty and one sister, Mary Elizabeth (Marty) Judd.

Herman Marty married Amila Sophia Catherine Von Fange on 1 January

1905 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Kansas. They lived together until Amilia's death on 1 May 1946. Herman married a second time to Emilie Hendrick. I do not know the date of their marriage but

plan to research this further at a later date. Herman and Emilie lived together until Herman's death in 1961.

I was under the impression that Herman had not served in the military, however recently I have been told there is a photo of him in military uniform. I shall also attempt to find out more about this.

As a young man Herman worked on the farm. In later years he was a painter by trade. Again my data is limited about his life's occupations.

Herman and Amlia had seven children. (A complete Family Group Record is enclosed in this newsletter.)

Herman Henry Marty was my grandfather. My remembrances of him are that his was a kind and gentle man.

Gottlieb Marti

(Update)

I still am at a loss to find any immigration or naturalization records for Gottlieb. I recently learned that Illinois Naturalization records were kept in Cook County (Chicago). And they burned in the 1871 Chicago fire. I have not given up searching for this information.

I have discovered that Gottlieb served with Company B of the 12th Illinois Volunteer Infantry Regiment during the Civil War. I am in the process of acquiring his military records from the National Archives in Washington, D.C. and tracking his unit through the Civil War. More on this in future issues. I find that

when Gottlieb signed up he was spelling his last name MARTI. By the time he was discharged the spelling had changed to MARTY. For some unknown reason the family name changed between 1861 and 1865 during the Civil War.

I also find where Gottlieb and Elizabeth sold land in Cass County, Illinois in 1880. I do not find any record of their purchasing this land so I am looking into the possibility of either Homesteading or Bounty Lands allowed to Civil War Veterans.

Another question arises from this land sale. Gottlieb is in Beardstown during the sale of this property in 1880, however, Elizabeth is in Chicago. This brings several new questions. I know that Elizabeth ends up in Lincoln County, Kansas. But Gottlieb never shows up on any records in Kansas. I wonder if Gottlieb and Elizabeth divorced and he went somewhere else. Or was she simply visiting in Chicago in 1880. And possibly Gottlieb died in route to Kansas and is buried along the trail someplace. I continue to work towards solving these mysteries. I hope to someday know the answers to my many questions.

I am not without places to look. I still have not searched tax records, divorce records, probate records or cemetery records just to name a few.
